

## IELTS level descriptors:

<p><b>IELTS 9</b> Expert User</p>	<p>Has fully operational command of the language: appropriate, accurate and fluent with complete understanding.</p>
<p><b>IELTS 8</b> Very Good User</p>	<p>Has fully operational command of the language with only occasional unsystematic inaccuracies and inappropriacies. Misunderstandings may occur in unfamiliar situations. Handles complex detailed argumentation well.</p>
<p><b>IELTS 7</b> Good User</p>	<p>Has operational command of the language, though with occasional inaccuracies, inappropriacies and misunderstandings in some situations. Generally handles complex language well and understands detailed reasoning.</p>
<p><b>IELTS 6</b> Competent User</p>	<p>Has generally effective command of the language despite some inaccuracies, inappropriacies and misunderstandings. Can use and understand fairly complex language, particularly in familiar situations.</p>
<p><b>IELTS 5</b> Modest User</p>	<p>Has partial command of the language, coping with overall meaning in most situations, though is likely to make many mistakes. Should be able to handle basic communication in own field.</p>
