

The Legal Services Board's decision on the consultation under section 70 of the Legal Services Act 2007 on a draft order to modify the functions of the Council for Licensed Conveyancers

Between 21 July 2014 and 18 August 2014 the Legal Services Board published a consultation paper¹ inviting representations on a recommendation and order under section 69 of the Legal Services Act 2007 which would have modified the functions of the Council for Licensed Conveyancers.

After the consultation closed, an alternative legislative option for achieving the required changes was identified. The changes proposed in the draft order consulted on were included in the Deregulation Act 2015 (sections 86 to 89); those sections came into effect on 29 June 2015².

In the light of this, at its meeting on 7 July 2015, the Board concluded that it no longer needed to make a recommendation to the Lord Chancellor on the proposed order.
